

# Homebuilders 2010-2011 Release & Information Form

## Homebuilders Release Form

Homebuilders is a group of Private Home Schooling Christian families who voluntarily choose to associate together. As such we seek to follow the biblical mandate which disallows bringing charges against Christian brothers in civil courts (1 Cor. 6: 1-8). The leadership is composed of those who have volunteered their time for the benefit of the group. We are an affiliate of Christian Home Educators Association of California (CHEA). Neither Homebuilders nor its leaders are liable for any injuries or damages resulting from the actions of others, whether connected with a group event or not. At every event, parents are responsible for the safety and behavior of their own children. The attitudes and actions of our families reflect upon the support group, upon home education at large, and upon the body of Christ. In accordance with Phil. 1:27 we encourage parents' to accept the following behavioral guidelines:

- 1) We will not allow our children to run unsupervised or to be a distraction to other participants at any group event.
- 2) We will obey the instructions of the tour guide, field trip planner or event sponsor. We also agree to follow any additional rules requested of us by a facility being used for meetings, activities, or field trips.
- 3) Our family will show respect for other people and their property (no litter, play only in designated areas, leave things in better condition than we found them).
- 4) Our family will dress appropriately for the occasion, wearing no clothing that is dirty, immodest, or in need of repair.
- 5) We will express verbal or written appreciation to our hosts. Children, including teenagers, are not allowed to attend any function without a parent or designated guardian. In the event a parent cannot attend a function he may ask another parent in the group to take responsibility for his child. If this is done the designated guardian should be comfortable enough to correct the child(ren) , if necessary. Also, provision of a written medical release form is suggested as a precautionary measure.
- 6) Participants at all Homebuilder co-ops and events MUST sign the Homebuilders release form. If a co-op or event coordinator wishes to have a more specific release form for his individual venue, such action is encouraged but not required.

We, the undersigned, have read and understood Homebuilders' mission and statement of faith. We agree to hold Homebuilders, its board, its small group leaders, and all field trip or activity coordinators harmless of liability in the event of any damages or injuries to us, to our children, or to our property. We also agree that we will take personal responsibility for our actions of our children, and of our guests, who damage property or who cause injury, whether willfully, through neglect, or by accident.
